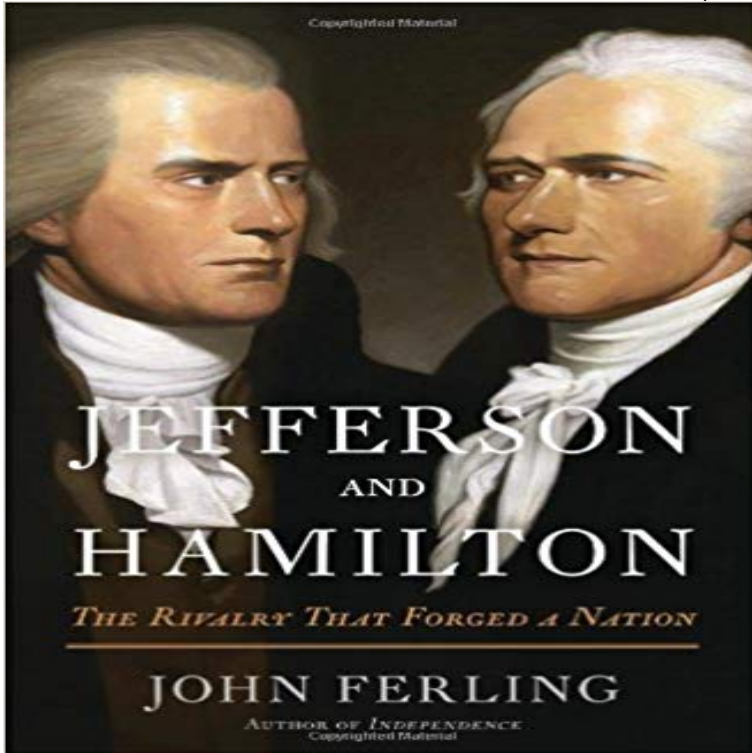


## Jefferson and Hamilton: The Rivalry That Forged a Nation
